

Minneapolis USBC Women's All City Team 2007 - 2008

Eligibility: All Minneapolis USBC Female certified bowlers are eligible provided they have bowled at least 60 games in a certified Minneapolis bowling league. The Season will begin August 1 and end by September 1st of the following year.

The 10 eligible bowlers with the most points will be named to the All City Team. (Top 5 will represent the Minneapolis USBC Women's All City Team and the top 6-10 point winners will represent the Honorable Mention Team).

An eligible bowler can receive points in each of the following categories:

1) Bowlers with the top 5 averages in Minneapolis scratch and/or handicap leagues, including mixed leagues will be awarded points on a 125-100-75-50-25 basis providing they average a minimum of 180. Sport League Averages will be adjusted according to USBC criteria.

This is awarded on a per league basis and bowlers shall be allowed to accumulate points in only two leagues, regardless of how many leagues in which they participate.

Determining Leagues to be counted - In order to determine the two leagues, the leagues with the most number of games will be used. If the same number of games occurs, then the league with the most points will be used.

Tie Breaker for All City Team to determine the top 10 bowlers – If a tie occurs in point totals, the person with the Highest Scratch All Events Score in the Minneapolis Women's City Tournament will be awarded the tie. If another tie occurs, the Highest Scratch Singles Score will prevail.

2) Points shall be awarded based on the Women's Scratch (Actual) finish in the tournaments listed below. It is up to the bowler to provide tournament recap sheets that verify any honor scores bowled that qualify for points.

Approved Major Tournaments: USBC Women's National Tournament, Minneapolis USBC Women's City Tournament, and Minnesota Women's State Tournament (All Events and Singles Scores), St. Paul/Minneapolis Queens Qualifier, National USBC Queens Tournament & National Team USA.

The top 10 actual all events and singles scores of eligible bowlers will be awarded the following points:

All Events 150-140-130-120-110-100-90-80-70-60
Singles 75-70-65-60-55-50-45-40-35-30

National Team USA:

75 points to make the team, 50 points if in the top 10 and 25 points for making cut.

In order to receive points for each tournament, you must place within the designated spots listed below:

National USBC Tournament– Singles and All Events – Posted Top 150 places.

Minneapolis USBC City Tournament – Full Prize List will be reviewed for 10 Minneapolis Bowlers.

Minnesota State USBC Tournament – Posted Top 100 places

National USBC Queens – Need to make the 1st cut, typically the top 100 places.

Minneapolis / St. Paul USBC Queens – will look down to the last casher in order to find the top 10 Minneapolis Bowlers.

Approved Minor Tournaments: The Minneapolis 600 and Minneapolis 700 Club Tournaments.

The top 5 actual scores of eligible bowlers will be awarded the following points:

3) The below honor counts will be recognized and awarded the following points:

Tournament Points (Approved listing only)

900 series (three games) – 100 points

800 series (three games) – 50 points

700 series (three games) – 10 points

300 game – 25 points

League Points

900 series (three games) – 100 points

800 series (three games) – 25 points

700 series (three games) – 5 points

300 game – 10 points

• Honor counts bowled in Sport Certified Leagues or Tournaments will be **DOUBLE POINTS**.

4) Highest 3 game **ACTUAL** series bowled in a Certified Minneapolis USBC league or Minneapolis USBC Tournament by an eligible bowler this season will be awarded 40 points.

5) Highest average (at least 60 games) in the Minneapolis USBC Association this season will be awarded 40 points.
